



## Send Mail/Send FDF Only

If **e-mailing a form**, you can cut down the transmission time by submitting the form data instead of the entire PDF. When the data is transmitted, it will travel as an FDF (Form Data File). The user at the other end of the connection can import the data into his/her PDF form. This of course requires an identical form with the same field names. To send FDF data via a script, use the following:

```
// use mailForm in this routine
this.mailForm(true, "name@address.com",
"", "", "Subject line message");
```

If you want a file to be sent to you from different users after they complete the form, you need to personalize the e-mail address.

To do so, add a name field. In the script, you can call the field contents where the user address is supplied. In this example, use something like:

```
// use mailForm in this routine
// gets the user address from a field
var f = this.getField("useraddress");
this.mailForm(true, f.value, "", "",
"Your form data is returned to you");
```

For an e-mail attachment where the PDF is to be sent instead of the FDF file, use:

```
// use mailDoc in this routine
// gets the user address from a field
var f = this.getField("useraddress");
this.mailDoc(true, f.value, "", "",
"Your completed PDF form is returned");
```
